	Points.
Head: Long, narrow, slightly curved on back and sides, wedge shaped..	15
Beak: Long, thin, straight, flesh colored	10
Eye cere: Red, fine in texture, thread like	5
Eye: Pearl white	15
Neck: Long and graceful	5
Chest: Round and full.	3
Wings: Held close to body and to rest above tail	2
Legs: Red, long, straight and free from feathers below the hock	4
Back: Long and straight	2
Shape: Long and slender	6
Carriage: Sprightly, erect	5
Color: Rich and sound	15
Markings: Ten (10) white primary flight feathers	10
Condition: Clean and vigorous	4

Colors.

Solid: Black, dun, red, yellow.

Barred: Blue, silver, silver dun, Isabella.

Blue and Silver to have black bars on tail and wing.

Silver Dun **to have dun bars on tail** and wing.

Isabella **to have yellow bars on tail.** and wing.

Mottles: Black, dun, red, yellow and blue. To be mottled as evenly as possible throughout body, with solid colored tail.
